### **Why should I join the PTO?**

We are glad you asked! The PTO directly supports your child's educational experience at SES. Parent involvement is imperative and studies have shown that students whose parents are involved excel at a higher rate than those who have no parental support in school. The PTO gives you an opportunity to voice your great ideas or concerns in a forum that matters! Your involvement will make a difference in a rewarding, positive, and tangible way. There is always a lot to do and we count on your support and generosity, which is part of what makes SES such a great school for our children. While we work hard, it is also a really fun way to meet new people and feel good about your commitment to our school. Remember, to have all the “extras” of the PTO, you must pay your family's \$5 membership dues.

### **How can I support the PTO?**

One of the great things about SES is that there is room for everyone, no matter how much time you have to volunteer. A list of PTO events and committees follows and we work hard to help you find a job that you enjoy and can be successful whether you have an hour a year or 5 hours a day! Opportunities include volunteering for single events (whether manning a check-in table or baking goodies for a bake sale), supporting our fundraisers, heading a committee, attending PTO meetings and events, giving to a child in need, volunteering in your child's class, spending a day sprucing up the playground, or making a monetary donation from you or your company.



Bringing your child to events such as Bingo Night, donating Coke Points, or linking your Target or Kroger card to SES's account are all ways to make a big difference.

### **Why all the fundraisers? What does the PTO Money fund?**

The PTO exists to enhance your child's educational experience through the cooperation of teachers, parents, and the community. The funds raised go directly back into the school to impact all SES students. The PTO helps to pay for field trips, playground equipment, school improvements and landscaping, teacher appreciation events, computers, iPads, teacher monetary classroom allotments, and many other events, activities, and supplements. Activities such as the SES 5K, the Fall Festival, and Bingo Night not only raise much-needed funds but are also a great way to be part of our SES family!

### **How does the PTO raise money?**

The PTO raises 100% of the funds used to support our great programs. Fundraising is designed in a variety of ways so that ALL parents can participate. Large events have included auctions, and sales drives. Smaller events include Bingo Night and 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Graders' Dance. Additionally, the PTO relies on community support including grants, donations, and loyalties. You can link your grocery saving card numbers to SES, bring in Box Tops, Campbell Soup Labels, and Coke Points, or best of all give a monetary donation! We make a big difference at SES and can't do it without your help. All monetary donations give SES 100% profit and are tax deductible. A real win-win!!

### **How much per child does the PTO aim to raise?**

While we are lucky to be in a great school division, the budget is very tight and the PTO works hard to enrich the experience for each child and teacher at SES. The money spent is far-reaching with broad appeal. As you think about our fundraising efforts, think about the experience you want your child to have at SES and how PTO programs have impacted your family. Think about our role in providing field trips, teacher supplies, and assemblies. Think about the fun you and your child have at our picnics, movie nights, Fall Festival, pizza parties, ice cream parties and other events---and please consider your contribution accordingly. **When are PTO Meetings? How do I know what's happening?**

The PTO meets once a month, on the second Tuesday at 6:30pm at SES. Attend these 15-30 minute meetings for an update. **What is a Room Parent/PTO Liaison?**

**We also have a few other great new ideas up our sleeves this year, so keep a (Wild Cat) eye out!**

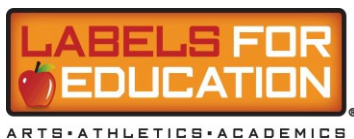

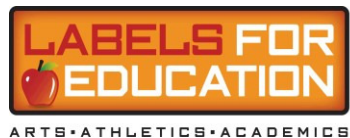


### **BOXTOPS:**
